REGISTRATION FOR SUMMER COURSE PROGRAMME – UG 2026

This notice is for UG students who have back papers in both odd and even semesters. Students are directed to register their willingness to enroll in the Summer Course to clear their back papers.

Registration Process

1. Use the Google Form link provided below to indicate your willingness to enroll in a course.
2. You may register your willingness for more than one course.
However, you can enroll in:
 - **Only one Core Course** (including Language and General English), and
 - **Only one Non-Core Course** (IGNITORS, HRD, Theology, Foundation Course).
3. The Google Form will be open from **25.02.2026 to 11.03.2026**

Important Notes

- Registering your willingness does not guarantee that the course will be offered during the summer.
- The administration will decide the courses to be offered based on the number of registrations and will notify students in the first week of April 2026.
- Students who were denied hall tickets for a single course and students who wish to improve their CA marks can also complete the course during this Summer Programme.

Eligibility

- All students who have failed in previous semester examinations are eligible to register for Summer Courses.
- Students who were denied hall tickets for one course are also eligible to register.
- Students may register for only one Core Course and one Non-Core Course during a given Summer Programme.
- No practical courses will be offered during summer registration.
- Both odd and even semester courses may be offered by the department.
- Classes for Non-Core Courses will be conducted for one or two days only.

Benefits

- 6th semester students having one back paper in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th semester can clear the course in summer and save one academic year.
- Students denied a hall ticket for a single subject can save one academic year by enrolling in the summer course (if offered).

- Improvement of Continuous Assessment (CA) marks is permitted only if the student appears for the Summer Examination in the concerned paper.

Course Details

- Classes will be conducted for one course only.
- Examinations will be conducted immediately after the classes.
- Total duration: 12 days

The following courses are not offered during the summer:

All PG courses, Practical courses, Dissertation, Project, Viva Voce, and Thesis


