NOTICE: REGISTRATION FOR THE FAST-TRACK SUMMER COURSES

Based on the willingness expressed by the students to attend the summer courses as per the notice number SJU/Exam/350/25-26 dated 25-02-2026, and also based on the number of students who failed to complete the given course, it is decided to offer a few courses in this summer session, 2026. The list of courses is attached to this notice.

Eligibility: All students having back papers in these courses are eligible to apply for the same. A student can register for one core course (including open electives) and more than one non-core course. All these courses and Open elective courses will be treated as supplementary attempts.

Application form: Application for the Fast Track Summer Session is attached. Students may download the same and submit it to the Examination Help Desk during the working hours of the help desk.

Fee: For Core courses including OE: One one-time fee of Rs 7500/for 3 Credit & Rs 9000 for 4 Credit paper must be paid (Tuition fee + supplementary examination Fee) in the exam section and the original fee paid receipt must be attached to the application form.

For non-core courses: One one-time fee of Rs 2500/- must be paid (Tuition fee + supplementary examination Fee) in the exam section and the original fee paid receipt must be attached to the application form.

Last date: The Last date to apply for the summer session is the **10th of April 2026**.

Course duration: All core courses and the open elective course will be conducted offline in the University campus. All non-core courses will be conducted online. The Session starts on the 11th May 2026. The final examinations will be held on the 25th of May 2026. Results will be published on the 15th of June 2026.

Note: -

• **Minimum Enrolment Requirement:** If the required number of students is not met for a subject, the course will be cancelled and the full amount will be refunded to the enrolled students.

• **No Cancellation by Students:** Once a student has applied and paid for the summer course, cancellations are not permitted and the amount will not be refunded.
