

Important Information for students (Fast-Track Summer Program-2026 May)

Key Dates:

1. **Commencement of the program: 11 May 2026.**
2. Faculty members will share a detailed syllabus with students, clearly specifying contact classes and library hours.
3. **Library Activities:**
 - Students must submit a **10-page assignment** based on their daily library activity (**5 assignments for the 3 credit courses and 6 for the 4 credit courses**).
 - Teachers can advise students to write assignments based on old question papers related to the topics covered/ To be covered in the library hours. This will help students:
 1. Reinforce their understanding of key concepts
 2. Practice applying knowledge to exam-style questions
 3. Develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills
4. **Assignment Submission:** Students should submit assignments to the teacher the following morning before the class.

@ To convert marks to a maximum of 20, the formula would typically be:

$$(\text{Converted Mark}) = (\text{Actual Mark} / \text{Maximum Possible Mark}) * 20$$

6. **Minimum attendance requirement for students, including library hours: 100%.**
8. **Library hours** will be monitored using **student library entry and exit records.**
9. To maintain the same blueprint and weightage as last year, the COE will randomly select end- semester exam question papers from the unused pool.
9. **Faculty members will create a WhatsApp group with students and share all the notices regarding the summer course.**
10. For each contact session, attendance will be noted, and students should maintain a disciplined learning environment.


