### Application for AICTE - Saraswati Scholarship Scheme for 1st Year BBA & BCA Girl Students

This is to inform all **eligible first-year girl students** enrolled in the **BBA and BCA** programs that applications are now open for the **AICTE – Saraswati Scholarship Scheme**. This scheme is specifically designed to provide assistance for the advancement of women pursuing technical education, empowering them with the skills and confidence for a successful future.

#### Scholarship Details:

- **Amount:** Eligible students will receive **Rs. 25,000 per annum** for every year of study (maximum 3 years) to cover college fees, books, equipment, and other educational expenses.
- **Selection:** Selection is based purely on the **merit of marks obtained in the 10+2** (or equivalent) examination.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be a girl student admitted to the **1st year** of a BBA or BCA degree level course.
2. Maximum of **two girl children per family** are eligible.
3. Total family income from all sources must not exceed **Rs. 8 lakh per annum** during the current financial year.
4. The gap between passing the qualifying examination and the session of admission should **not exceed two years**.
5. The student **must not be receiving any other financial assistance** (scholarship, salary, or stipend) from any other source.
6. An **Aadhaar number is mandatory** for the application.

#### How to Apply:

1. Eligible candidates must **apply online** through the **National Scholarship Portal (NSP)** or the **AICTE Saraswati Scholarship Portal**.
2. Ensure you have a valid income certificate issued by the State/UT Government.
