Session	Details
<b>Arrival &amp; Classroom Allocation</b>	Students guided to classrooms by mentors; attendance taken.
<b>Ice-Breaker &amp; Self-Introduction</b>	Interactive games and peer introductions to build comfort and connection.
<b>Overview of the College</b>	General introduction to the campus, SJU’s mission, student life, and infrastructure.
<b>Interaction with the Dean</b>	Insights into academic culture, university support, values, and regulations.
<b>Address by Welfare Officers</b>	Overview of student welfare services, attendance regulations, procedures for reporting medical or personal concerns, and the support mechanisms available to assist students during their studies.
<b>Break-(15 mins) : 10.30 - 10.45 am</b>	Informal interactions among students can be encouraged; they may use the restrooms.
<b>General English Screening</b>	English language proficiency screening conducted to assess students and facilitate their placement into CS1 and CS2 groups.
